Dear Taikura community,

While I very much enjoyed last weeks Autumn festival and play, I was quite shocked by the number of parents waving their phones around filming and photographing. This prompted me to check in the parent handbook exactly what the ruling is.

The following excerpts are taken directly out of the Parent Handbook:

From Page 16 Mobile Phones / Electronic Devices:

"From a health and well-being point of view, and because of their misuse, we have decided to implement a ban on the use of all mobile phones on the school grounds and directly outside the front gate. We ask parents to respect this also".

Page 25 Use of Cameras. Videos and Phone Cameras:

"Camera-phones are now an accessory for many people and with them comes the consciousness that every event is ripe for "capturing".....We ask that plays, festivals, Community Assemblies and class performances held indoors not be photographed or videoed.....We also want you to be part of an active and engaged audience and not removed by placing a camera between yourself and the event, or distracting others in the audience by doing so".

These guidelines are very clear. Can we as a community please be conscious of the behaviour that we are role-modelling for our children (In this case, flaunting school rules).
