Eight years ago, I visited John Fullwood's class for the first time. He was a semi-retired maths teacher in his late 70s who told me that as a maths teacher, the only thing I should never drop was problem solving.

John is a legend and an institution in Hawkes Bay's 'maths circles'. He has been organizing not just the annual Mathletics competitions and Maths' camps but is an inspiration for many students, teachers, parents and community members.

Taikura School has been participating in his programmes for seven years but also we have competed for the past three years in the Otago University Problem Challenge and a small training programme for the regional Mathletics's competition.

These events are opportunities for our students to see themselves as part of the wider Hawkes Bay school community and vice-versa as other schools collaborate with us too. This interdependent work fosters innovation and a push or excellence in both ways!

This term four, groups of three students and several understudies are preparing for the September Maths games. Two and half arduous hours of computation endurance, algebraic thinking and geometrical puzzling! Four years in a row we won the silver award, and this year we will push for gold!!

Dear Whanau and Friends

It is almost certain that a nation wide teachers' strike, organized by the NZEI Te Riu Roa Teacher's Union, will be going ahead next week on Wednesday 15 August.

Taikura's Union members **are not** part of this strike as the negotiations are not for the Area Schools' teachers. However, we wholeheartedly support the claims made to the government as those will be almost the same for the Area Schools' Collective agreement in the coming year.

It has been interesting to listen to the media. Their reports at times have been misleading as they were presented briefly and with little substance. Often they reported only on the pay increase offered but omitted the claims related to the deep-seated and fundamental issues facing the profession. There is a crisis in recruitment and retention of teachers and principals. Teachers and principals have consistently raised high workloads (even without National Standards), there is 40% fewer students training to be teachers, schools are struggling to attract teachers, there are not enough resources available for supporting children with additional learning needs, including Specialists and support staff. The pay scale has also fallen behind other professions which is happening because of years of the political undervaluing of the profession.

If you are interested, go to the NZEI website and read about the campaign. It is important we are well-informed citizens who have an interest in the future of Aotearoa.


