He pito kōrero!

At Taikura we endeavour to build and strengthen tikanga Māori, making these a natural part of our daily rhythm in our classrooms and learning environments. Two of these are listed below.

Tikanga 101:

- **Speaking**

Avoid entering and crossing a room while someone in authority is addressing an audience. To avoid offence, either wait quietly by the door until there is a break in the dialogue or, when that is not appropriate, enter as discretely as possible. Try not to walk directly in front of the speaker or, if you cannot avoid it, crouch down as you pass as a sign of respect. Why? Traditionally Māori society is very hierarchical and crossing in front of a more 'senior' person is considered rude.

- **Pillows**

Avoid sitting directly on pillows or cushions that are also used to rest your head on. Your head is considered to be tapu in te ao Māori, and therefore a pillow used at sleep or rest time is separate from those that are used to sit on.

Kīwaha o te wikiKīwaha of the week!

Kai parāoa! (ka ee pah do or ah)

Easy as/Easy peezy!

Hemi: Kia ora e hoa, how was that test?

Rangi: Kai parāoa e hoa, kai parāoa!

He pito kōrero is a space dedicated to celebrating and promoting Te Reo me ōna Tikanga Māori.
