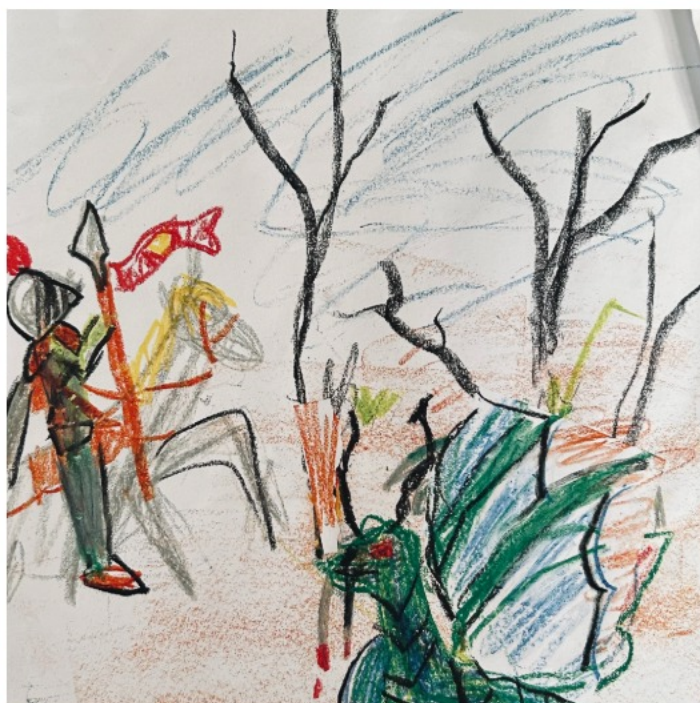
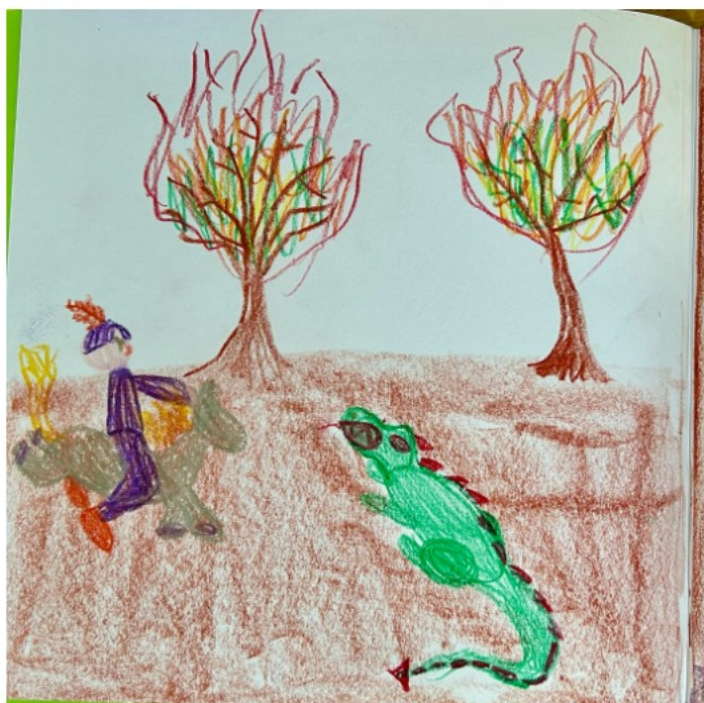
Fabric Wanted for the High School Handwork Room

High School Athletics

Following on from a fantastic Taikura High School Athletics Day, three senior boys qualified for and represented the school on Wednesday 19 March 2025 at the East Coast North Island Athletic Championship.

Yudi represented the school in the 3000m track run to get a creditable 4th overall and in the 1500m to get a well-earned 4th again. He was up against runners who train regularly and in the 3000m in hot conditions out-sprinted a young man in the last 20 metres to earn his 4th place.

Unfortunately, both Ian and Louis were carrying injuries into the competition and were unable to perform to the standard that they had previously shown but these young men did compete and were a credit to the school. They gained valuable experience and are keen to compete in the ECNI Athletics competition again next year.


