To Josh Achten who finished 2nd overall and first in his age group in the K2 cycling race held in the Coromandel, this race is over 200km in length with approximately 2400 metres of hill climb and one of the hardest cycling races in The Southern Hemisphere. Well done Josh!

Surfing Club:

This will start Friday 25 November

This is a loosely formed club that has grown over the years. It consists of a group of parents and students numbering between 10 and 50 depending on the weather and surf conditions.

We meet at the south end of Waimarama beach domain at 4:15 pm approximately every Friday during the Terms One and Four. There is a wide range of surfing abilities within the group. There is also a keen group of parents who surf along side their children.

Surfing lessons are provided to children and adults during the first hour after our arrival at the beach. Those who wish to have a lesson need to request one as soon as they arrive at the beach. The school has a set of surfboards available for these lessons and any spares not being used are able to be used by students without their own boards. This activity is suitable for children from Class 3 onwards.

The school does not provide supervision for children in the water. Every child who attends must have an adult with them who is prepared to supervise them in the surf and on the beach. At times parents designate one adult to watch a small group of children while they are surfing then swap over. **This is a private arrangement and not monitored by me.**

The reason I am unable to supervise this activity is because I am focusing on giving lessons to individuals or out surfing myself. Any child receiving a lift in another family's car should provide them with a koha towards petrol.

Could regular attendees please pay \$10 to the school sports coordinator at the school office to offset the price of surfboard wax, repairs, leg ropes etc
